EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Williams reported on the following items:

- A cosmetic wall was placed in front of the old Tsunami location
- All-gender restroom construction is moving forward
- Hill Top Shop is now open
- Global Viewpoint Lounge project is moving forward
- Ackerman Union 1st floor restroom has a TGIF grant to install low-flow fixtures

T-SHIRT DESIGN CONTEST

- Current t-shirt sales are lagging approximately half of last year.
- The Committee discussed possible ideas for the upcoming contest including t-shirt color and styles. The Committee agreed to exclude a black shirt this year.

SUSTAINABILITY UPDATE
